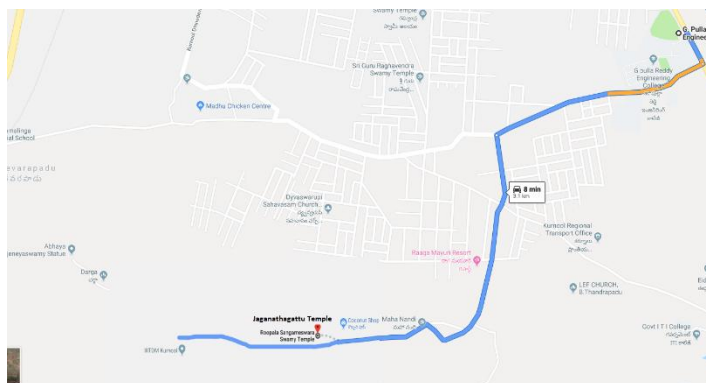

1. **How to reach IIITDM Kurnool:** The campus is about 12 KMs from Kurnool City Railway station, and 3 KMs from G. Pulla Reddy Engineering College, Kurnool.
