The written test (100 Marks) comprises two parts:

1. **Part A:** Engineering Mathematics and Aptitude. Weightage of 40 marks.
2. **Part B:** Based on the specialization opted (CSE/ECE/ME); Weightage of 60 marks.
3. The total duration of the exam will be **two hours**.
4. Refer the notification on website for detailed syllabus of the written test in *Annexure-I*.
5. Candidates will receive 1 mark for each correct response, and a negative marking of 0.5 marks will be applied for every incorrect response.

Instructions to Shortlisted candidates:

1. The **Written Test** will be conducted in offline mode/online mode as per the above-indicated schedule.
2. The candidates are instructed to bring the following **originals** with a copy of self-attested documents for verification.
 - a) SSC/Class X certificate in support of Date of Birth
 - b) Intermediate/ (10+2) / Class XII certificate.
 - c) Provisional Certificate / Degree Certificates and Grade/Marks Memos of the qualifying examinations.
 - d) No Objection Certificate from the employer, (if employed).
 - e) Relieving certificate from the employer (at the time of admission).
 - f) Recent Passport Photograph (2 in No.).
 - g) Application Fee payment receipt with transaction number.
3. Candidate may note that change of date of examination/center will not be entertained.
4. The admit card must be presented for verification at the time of examination, along with at least one original (Not photocopy) and valid photo Identification card (e.g., Aadhar, PAN Card, Driving License, Passport etc.)
5. Candidates will not be allowed to enter the examination hall after the commencement of the examination.
6. Mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets, electronic watches are not allowed inside the examination hall.
7. Bring **duly filled admit card** for entering the examination hall.
8. Document verification, Seat allotment and Fee collection (Partial seat acceptance fee) are scheduled immediately (**On the same day**) **after the announcement of results of the written test**.
