Mode of Selection: The selection process consists of an Online Interview.

They should satisfy themselves, before applying that they possess at least the minimum essential qualifications, work experience etc. as laid down in the advertisement.

- d) No correspondence by any means will be entertained from candidates regarding postal delays, conduct & result of interview, reasons for not being called for interview.
