Central Sanskrit University (CSU), under Ministry of Education, Govt. of India has sanctioned the project entitled “**Finding the Fake News Propagated Related to Our Ancient Scriptures**” under the Scheme Ashtaadashi for the year 2024-2025.

To combat the misrepresentation of culturally significant texts like the Ramayana and Mahabharata, this research introduces a deep learning model integrating XLNet, Attention Mechanisms, BiGRU, and Logistic Regression. This advanced framework analyzes intricate linguistic layers and contextual relationships to accurately detect misinformation and distinguish true statements from false ones. By leveraging AI for verification, the project aims to safeguard the integrity of ancient artifacts and preserve their irreplaceable cultural and historical value.

Since this is a culture oriented project, the students are expected to have a basic knowledge of Hindu Scriptures and the main hindu schools of philosophies. They should be ready to read and learn about new ancient hindu scriptures also. For Traditional Scholars: Scholars who are presently pursuing their BA (Sanskrit) final year or MA (Sanskrit) second year or equivalent degree in some UGC recognized educational institution. Students who have recently completed BA or MA in June/July 2026 can also apply. Scholars who are studying in traditional Gurukula System can also apply provided they are less than or equal to 24 years of age and should be certified by regular faculty from any reputed Central government Sanskrit institution. Additionally, they should be able to read and write Sanskrit. Since this is a culture oriented project, the students are expected to have a basic knowledge of Hindu Scriptures and the main hindu schools of philosophies. They should be ready to read and learn about new ancient hindu scriptures also. Irrespective of Scholars or Engineers, both should have strong commitment and zeal towards contributing to our culture, values and scriptures.
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Tenure of appointment: The paid internship is from August 10, 2026 to Nov 10, 2026 (3 Months). However, based on the performance, the paid internship can be extended upto a maximum of 6 months with stipend. In case, if the intern drops out in the middle, only the completed month will be taken for all official purposes including stipend. This is offline internship.

Mode of Selection: The selection process consists of an Online Interview.

1. Instructions to the Applicants:

- a) The posts are on a purely temporary basis.
- b) Candidates are required to carefully go through the details of qualifications, experience, and instructions available on the Institute website. They should satisfy themselves, before applying that they possess at least the minimum essential qualifications, work experience etc. as laid down in the advertisement.
- c) Incomplete/ partially filled offline applications and CVs will not be considered.
- d) No correspondence by any means will be entertained from candidates regarding postal delays, email checking delays, conduct & result of interview, reasons for not being called for interview.
